Program Overview

The WIT SMP Alumni Technical Certification Program is designed to help participants prepare for and earn high-demand technical certifications that strengthen career readiness and support long-term career advancement. Certification opportunities will be ongoing, with specific study periods and timelines announced in advance, allowing participants and partners to engage when schedules align.

Certifications are selected based on labor-market demand, employer input, and guidance from WIT partners, ensuring participants build relevant, marketable technical skills. Priority certification areas include CompTIA A+, CompTIA Security+, CompTIA Network+, Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA), and Microsoft Azure.

Participants complete self-paced, expert-led coursework within a structured, mentor-supported cohort model. Study periods will typically range from 8–12 weeks for foundational certifications and extend to 12–20 weeks for more advanced credentials, depending on the certification.

Partners & SME Engagement

- WIT is seeking subject matter experts to support the program by hosting a virtual 1-hour, mentor-led small-group study sessions each week throughout the study period. These sessions reinforce technical concepts, provide accountability, and offer real-world insight as participants prepare for certification exams.
